

Acts Retained

The following is a list of the statutes which have provisionally been proposed for retention in the Statute Law Revision (Pre-Union) Bill 2006. This will comprise an exclusive list of all statutes in force dating from before 1st January 1801.

Some of the Acts listed here will only be temporarily retained, as they are scheduled for repeal in other legislation. For example, “1455 (33 Hen. 6) c. 9 - Ships guarding the sea between Ireland and England to have certain tolls” is one of a number of Acts that will be repealed by the Sea Fisheries and Maritime Jurisdiction Bill, when that Bill passes into law.

Other Acts will be repealed by the Registration of Deeds and Title Bill 2004 (when enacted and commenced), the proposed Land and Conveyancing Bill (when enacted and commenced) and the Civil Registration Act 2004 (when fully commenced).

Note that short titles marked with an asterisk (thus*) are not the short titles currently in effect, but are proposed amended short titles.
